DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The rowhouse is two bays wide and 2½ stories high. The facade has been refaced in formstone and fenestration is symmetrical.

The first story facade is punctuated by a flat door to the left with its accompanying flat boarded over transom. These elements surmount four concrete steps and a concrete stoop. To the right the facade is punctuated by a large double hung flat window of one over one lights.

The second story facade is punctuated by two flat windows double hung with one over one lights.

The roof is high pitched with a centered dormer carrying a flat window of one over one lights,

Representative of domestic architecture of the 1840's and surviving into the 20th century relatively, intact at least on exterior. George E. Howard built these houses on property willed to him by his father, John Eager Howard. The houses were completed in 1841.




