DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Four stories high and four bays wide, this building is laid in common bond. The first story has been completely altered: covered with wood siding topped by a metal cornice, it now contains two doors in flat arch wooden frames, and four single hung windows, two with ten lights and two with thirty.

Windows of the upper stories are all double hung with two-over-two lights, stone sills, and marble segmental arch, drip-moulded lintels which terminate in brackets. The moulded roof cornice is braced and has a small bracket at either end of the facade.
