DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

**PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

These four isolated buildings exist in joint composition, and are ~~the~~ identical. Each four story facade is three bays wide with an altered street level storefront. Symmetrical fenestration punctuates the facade. The double hung windows with 2/2 lights are accented by ~~brownstone~~ brownstone sills and terra cotta detailing. Corbelled and notched brick ornamentation further defines the facade.

Each storefront has <sup>A</sup> central entrance flanked by display windows, with corporate signs partially hiding the moldings which at one time functioned as cornices. The building walls are accented by brownstone bands with notched brick detailing between <sup>ve</sup> projecting panels with circular foliated detailing unite the cornice slabs.

The second and third floors are identical, though many of the segmentally arched windows have been boarded. Brownstone sills underline three windows of each floor. The lintels boast beaded terra cotta detailing and are united by stone skew blocks.. The buildings' walls are accented by notched brick.

The three rectangular windows on the fourth floor carry stone sills and flat arch brick lintels joined by skew blocks. They are mounted by terra cotta string courses.

Exaggerated brick corbelling forms the cornice, capped by projecting stone molding. The building walls have minor brick corbel detailing surmounted by gabled rosetted pinnacles with sunflower finials.



