DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This building is located in the middle of the block and was constructed circa 1860. It is three stories high and three bays wide and has a flat roof.</p> <p>The brick exterior (laid in running bond) is accented by flat stone lintels and sills. The other significant architectural element of the house, the doorway, is flanked by two stone posts and a lintel with oval decoration on the key stone.</p> <p>A stone stoop with five steps flanked by a wrought iron hand rail leads to the doorway, which is surmounted by a plain transom.</p> <p>Symmetrical fenestration proportionally scaled from first to third floors punctuates the facade. The windows on the second and third story are double hung with two-over-two lights. A wooden cornice with a row of modillions and a row of dentils crowns the building.</p> <p>There is a small grass yard with a wrought iron fence.</p>
