DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>When built in the 1860's these two rowhouses, now owned and operated as a unit, were constructed in the same manner as the row house located at 938 N. Calvert Street. Each rowhouse is three stories high and three bays wide and has a flat roof. The rowhouses are located between the center and end of the block.</p> <p>The brick exterior (laid in running bond) is accented by flat stone lintels and sills, and decorative wooden and stone belt courses. The other significant architectural element of the houses, the doorways, have been altered. The original doorway of 934 has become a window and the original entrance at 936 has been extended to the ground level. Two additional entrances have been created at the ground level. To the left of the main entrance is the Calvert Food Market entrance. To the right of the main entrance is an entry to an office. There are three steps leading to the main central entrance which has been unfortunately altered.</p> <p>Outside the Calvert Food Market, is a Pepsi Cola Machine. There is a small tree in front of the building.</p> <p>The stone posts and lintels of the original doorways with their cornices remain intact.</p> <p>Symmetrical fenestration, proportionally scaled from first to third floors, punctuates the facade. The windows are double hung with two-over-two lights. A wooden cornice with brackets and dentils adorns the roofline.</p>
