Notable features:


These are houses of good, severe style which should be rehabilitated. The tall windows to the floor at 312-316, simple cornices and well-proportioned windows make this an especially nice set.

Environmental context:

The street is wide and barren but not heavily traveled; it needs street trees. The block has a number of narrow alleys and the dwellings on Sarah Ann Street crowd the interior areas, but with some fencing of yards and demolition of rundown auxiliary buildings the backs could be made more useful and pleasant.


