



Although not as good a group as those opposite and west of it, this row of later buildings should, with the possible exception of number 1121, be retained to keep the street enclosed. If a park were provided and the number of tenants kept low, there would be no density problem. Number 1111 has a first floor modification that should be removed.

Environmental context:

Lots at 1103-1107 have been cleared but appear to be used for some sort of tank storage. It is a nicely scaled street with houses the smallness of which is ideal for young couples or older people, but too small for families. Numbers 1121, 1119 and 1117 are vacant houses.
