

Notable features:



Isolated, small houses (1005, 1007, 1019) same as the isolated ones across-street makes a re-use dependent upon a new plan for the block. The fenced blacktop area (1009-1013) is ludicrous as a public playground. Continuity and good maintenance of most of 1023-1041 row augurs for rehabilitation.

Environmental context:

Numbers 1009-1013 are open blacktop; next 28' are rears of Saratoga Street lots, one having a one-story garage on it; then 1019 stands free next to a cleared lot at 1021; a very fragmented scene. Numbers 1019-1041 should be incorporated in a new plan for this small, quiet street.
