Notable features:

Number 235 is recently burned out. Other houses in the terrace are in good condition; there is a bar at the north corner. It is in no way a distinguished group but is of a useful size. The burned out house should be repaired forthwith; it damages the appearance of this otherwise good terrace. The cornices have been replaced at 237-239 with heavy substitutes. Number 245 has a completely rebuilt front.

Environmental context:

This is a wide but not so busy street; pleasant and picturesque continuity of purple plum street trees adds human scale to this block. There is good house-to-house scale and interesting contrast to houses across the street and to the church on the south.
