

Notable features:


These houses and sundry out buildings are scheduled for demolition because of their poor structural condition.

Environmental context:

Numbers 1014, 1022, 1024, 1023, 1025 are vacant of the 16 remaining scattered houses on the 67-some lots, the remainder of which have been cleared except for two one-story garages, two one-story sheds and a fenced junk yard. All in all, an unsightly mess but has potential of a quiet, small-scaled living environment.
