Notable features:

Number 901 has a shop front on Lexington Street which suggests the house may have been redesigned for the installation of the shop because the design of the shop looks later than the rest of the building. Like most of the corner buildings in the area, this one is visually important for its size, chimneys and side windows. It has a quality of variety which assists the appearance of the whole terrace. Numbers 903-907 are characteristic 2½ story buildings of the 1850's; number 903 has an original door surround, and the door at 905 is probably original.

Environmental context:

Number 903 is vacant and formstoned. A wide, busy street; no street trees; good house-to-house scale and continuity. Poe Homes is across the street.
