

Notable features:

This is a notable group of steeply gabled, single dormer houses, raised above the street, with basements. A typical group with brick corbelled cornice, set on shallow lots, with fine tree shading the fronts. The houses step up with the street grade.

Environmental context:

Numbers 113, 117 and 121 are vacant. Wide but quiet street. Large Linden tree at 119/121 is an excellent specimen; street trees should be added. House-to-house scale is excellent; across-street scale is good. Street rises to a dead-end at Lexington Street.
