Notable features:

The Sachse view of 1869 shows these houses standing. The Hopkins Atlas, 1876, shows the Drovers and Mechanics Bank as occupying this building, as well as the corner on Baltimore Street adjacent to it. The small Drovers and Mechanics Bank building at 2 N. Carey (now a church) has considerable quaintness and charm. Its dates are between 1865 and 1876; the bank was chartered in 1874. To maintain the character of Baltimore Street, it should be forthwith protected.
