

Notable features:

St. Paul's -- appears in 1871 Baltimore City Directory as a Methodist Episcopal Church on W. Fayette Street near Republican Street. It does not appear in the Directories before 1869, so its building date is possibly 1868-69. It is now heavily formstoned with a new but less than beautiful parish hall on its east side. It is now the Morningstar Baptist Church.

Environmental context:

Socially and visually significant. The large parking lot (1069-1075) on west needs planting, walls, etc., to allow a small compensation for the four large houses demolished to make way for the field of asphalt.



