

Notable features:

There were sallyports between each two houses; most are blocked up. Numbers 32 and 34 are early buildings with single dormers and gable roofs. They may indeed be a little earlier than the date assigned to them. They have wood sills and number 34 has round-headed windows which does not alter the date assigned. All the cornices are very severe and thus early.

Environmental context:



Demolition opposite and to the north and west leaves these houses isolated. All are vacant except for Emma's Tavern and next door, 24 and 22. Lots 68-72 south on Poppleton and 88-82 west on Fairmount have been cleared. Some pleasant Ailanthus trees in the rear. Nice house-to-house scale but nothing to relate to except cleared land in most directions. New plans for area should incorporate these small houses.
