Notable features:

Number 1201/1205 is financial Classical Revival; has a certain quality. Number 1213 is a two-story with dormer; is early, probably before 1840 (see attached tax record). Numbers 1217-1221 come from the late 1840's. All the others are replacements for earlier buildings.

As early as 1851 the block was built up solidly, with buildings like numbers 1213 and 1217-1221.

Numbers 1209 and 1211 have nice original shop fronts. The modern shop fronts are not attractive and ugly signs cover up some of the old shop front details. Formstone at 1209 is most unfortunate.

Environmental context:

Good commercial stands. Row could be improved with paint, a modest regulation of signage and opening up of blocked-up windows. Across the street a motley collection of commercial buildings -- see block 199.
