Notable features:

Three old buildings, modern building at 1123/1125 and 1141/1143. The former is not handsome but is useful; is currently for sale. Number 1141/1143 is quite interesting design with small windows at attic level.

Signs and modernized store fronts block any appreciation one could have for the buildings. Numbers 1133-1135, 1137-1139 have been formstoned and 1141/1143 has been stuccoed.

Environmental context:

Baltimore Street commercial blight. The variety, scale and remaining details of these buildings could be made into a positive quality. The street signs, lights, furniture, pavings, etc., also need upgrading.
