Notable features:

Numbers 6-8 are the old pottery works. The building was certainly there in 1876 and tax accounts (see attached sheet) would indicate there was a pottery works there as early as 1840. Also see notice of sale in 1843 Sun (attached).

Numbers 12-10 are an industrial building which has a date of 1880 on it. Number 18 is dated by its brick work; it is a loft building.

In 1858 this block contained several shed-roofed houses, a long row of gabled houses where 6-8 now stand. This block underwent change after the Civil War.

Environmental context:

Number 18 is vacant; a new and alternate use for it should be found, could be residential. Number 10-12 is sealed but seems to be used via Booth Street side; different window treatment should be found. Street trees are needed. Large, unrelieved school yard opposite to Booth Street. There are houses opposite from Booth to Baltimore Street.



