Notable features:

Numbers 906, 908, 910 and 920 have been formstoned. This is a row of fairly early (before 1851) houses of modest size but characteristic gable roof form. Two story with attic as at 922 and 920 is essentially an early form. These may be the oldest houses in this group. Numbers 914 and 924 are probably 1880's replacements for earlier houses.



This old (1840's - early 1850's) terrace should be retained. Numbers 900 and 908 should be repaired before further damage is done to them.

Environmental context:

Vacant houses are at 900, 908 and 922. Lombard is one of the most heavily travelled one-way streets in Poppleton and certainly the noisiest. In spite of this, the houses are in fairly good maintenance. Street trees struggle; larger ones should be planted. Good house-to-house and across-street scale.
