Notable features:

A row of mid-19th century houses, badly abused by lack of care, use of buildings for storage, degeneration and dirt of the Market area, vacant lot filled with trash. Shop fronts are at 1117, 1121, 1141; more first floor shops would be in keeping with the Market. The remodelling (or new building) at 1143/1145 is ugly and out-of-keeping with the rest of the block. Numbers 1125-1129 and 1135, 1137 have been formstoned.

The row should be rehabilitated along with the Market house and retailing stalls within it.

Environmental context:

Number 1119 is a vacant lot; house number 1123 is vacant. (See comment on street for 1101-1115 Hollins Street.)
