Notable features:

All are 3-story gable houses except 119 which is a 3-story flat roofed building. Number 1247 W. Lombard is big and formstoned. An undistinguished but well-cared-for row, full of formstone: numbers 117, 115, 109, 107, and 103. Numbers 103 and 113 retain 6/6 windows. There is a large and ugly sign on the side of 119.


Environmental context:
