Notable features:

Numbers 1116-1118 have been heavily rebuilt; may be a remodelled gable, 2½ story with attic. Most of the row is workers' housing, mid-19th century, now well cared for but formstoned (numbers 1100-1108, 112, 1114). Number 1112 has original door. Number 1124 is a store front church (white congregation). The little two story houses 1120-1122 need help.

Environmental context:

No gaps and no vacant houses. Pratt Street is one-way with heavy traffic. Street trees are good; need to be fed. B. & O. shops are opposite.
