**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The first story of the two story, five bay building has been covered by aluminum siding, otherwise, the rest of the structure remains shingled. The five, second story windows are double hung, 1/1 with plain trim and shutters. Two gable dormers with overhang are contained by the halifax mansard roof front. Each dormer contains a double hung, two sash with mullion window. The boxed cornice is decorated with brackets.


