DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The two story, two bay, end related, attached brick rowhouses have end gables with centre, chimney-like projections. At either end of the row are gabled open porches while the two centre homes share an open roofed porch.

The first story windows for the end houses are double hung, 6/6 and are found on opposite ends of the row. The first story windows which serve the center of the row are two sash with mullion, otherwise they are of identical construction.

Second story decoration is found in the end-brick slipsill, the design of which is reinforced by its surface continuation along the wall. The windows are again, double hung, 6/6.


