DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The row of attached, two story, two bay homes are of common bond brick construction. Each residence has its own flat roofed porch with wrought iron on pier supports and low, connecting masonry walls.

The main entrance and first story windows have plain stone lintels and lugsills. The homes alternate in the inclusion of leaded glass flush or recessed blind transoms over the doorway and first story windows.

Over the double hung, 1/1 second story windows is a stylized radiating arch with key-stone design. The stepped level of each individual residence is visually reinforced by the inclusion of a bracket which also separates the plain boxed cornice at that particular point. The brackets also serve to hold a line of raised moulding which is attached below the cornice.


