DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The end-block, stucco and Spanish tile, 2-story residence is almost entirely hidden from view by pine trees. Rectangular casement windows with brick sills accent the facade, which features an front entrance piggy-backed by a balcony and a front porch with a Spanish tile roof. An unusual element is the mosaic tile insignia above the central porch entrance.

Four fieldstone steps lead to the round-headed wooden door in the left bay. Six lights, the upper 2 rounded, fill the upper section of the door, which is protected by a Spanish tile shed roof supported by brackets.

The central entrance boasts a round-headed stucco entranceway leading to a square, wooden door. The 2nd story balcony is reached by French windows.

Another Spanish tile shed roof projects above the right side balcony.

A rounded opening with wrought iron front grillework brings light into the interior with the aid of 2 casement windows with 4 vertical lights flanked by 4 vertical fixed sidelights. The 2nd floor of this bay holds 2 rectangular casement windows with brick header sills.

Above the 2nd story windows is a series of metal pipe open ends. To the right of the house is a small shaped wall behind which stands a stone fountain.


