DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

5600 Clearspring is a group of two story, three bay rowhouses built of a variation of common bond red brick (every seventh row has alternating headers and stretchers). The end house, 5600 Clearspring, has a gabled roof with the gable end in the front facade. A pedimented boxed cornice houses a round-arched ventilator. Pilasters of brick flank the front facade. There are three case-ment windows of the second story. Each window has two vertical sashes, with each sash containing four lights. All three windows are attached with a con- tinuous sill of brick headers. The first story window is fixed, and has a flat- topped transom of three lights. There are nine lights in the main window divi- sion. The main entrance, situated on the right, is surrounded by a plain architrave.

Other homes of the row are similarly designed except for the gable end above the second story, and a few minor variations. These includes a plain pedimented door frame, various designs of the first story window, and no flanking pilasters. All of the homes have terraced front yards.

5600 Clearspring is situated among a quiet post-World War II residential develop- ment.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

5600 Clearspring Road is typical of much of the post-World War II residential development that mainly occurred in the eastern third of Govans between Lake Avenue and Beaverbrook Road. Various treatments of roofs, windows, doors, porches, brick, landscaping and layout can be observed among this basic type of two story, red brick rowhouse located in Govans.



