DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

6203 York Road is a utilitarian frame building of one and a half stories and four bays. A slate-shingled gabled roof is decorated by two shed dormers and brick chimneys located on the left exterior side and center exterior. Clapboard is the exterior wall material. Windows are double-hung with 4/4 lights. An open front porch is covered by a simple awning supported by three wood piers.

This building, once a tollhouse, is located within a comparatively quiet section of the busy York Road commercial corridor.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The York Turnpike was constructed in 1786 by the State of Maryland with the intention of encouraging trade between Baltimore and the hinterland to the north. Serving this purpose well, York Road brought many farmers to trade in Baltimore from as far away as Pennsylvania. As the travelers of the York Turnpike approached Baltimore, tolls of five cents per horse were collected at several points; in Waverly at Vineyard Lane, in Govanstown at Rossiter Avenue, and north of Govanstown at 6203 York Road (near Cedar-croft Road). This tollhouse, installed later than the other two, is the only one remaining intact.





