DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Gregory Memorial Church was built as a simple, shingled country church. The floor plan is rectangular, the nave encompassing the entire floor. A gabled roof, with slightly projecting eaves and a simple trim, tops the church. Windows, double hung with 2/2 lights and plain surrounds, are placed in three bays along the side and on either side of a projecting closed porch at the front. The main entrance has a double leafed door with a flat-topped transom. A half-round window above the porch may have originally contained stained glass. It is presently painted.

The present Knights of the Golden Eagle Lodge is located on a short, quiet, dead-end street that is lined with late nineteenth century shingled, cottage style houses.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Gregory Memorial Baptist Church started as a mission in 1890 under the sponsorship of the Huntingdon Baptist Church of Waverly. The original building, still standing on Lyman Avenue one block from the present church, was opened on May 2, 1897. It was originally called Govanstown Baptist, but was renamed Gregory Memorial Baptist in 1917 in honor of Dr. Robert Fuller Gregory, pastor from 1913-1919. Gregory's present church, located at 5701 York Road, was completed in 1919 and opened in 1920.

The building at 410 Lyman Avenue, presently the Knights of the Golden Eagle Lodge, reflects the wooden cottage style of architecture that was popularly used in Govans in the late nineteenth century. Most of the homes along Lyman Avenue are composed in this style.



