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 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE
 

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601 Woodbourne Avenue is a two story wooden cottage style house with an "L" floor plan. The exterior wall material is painted clapboard. A slate shingled, gabled roof caps the house. In the front gable end is a jerkin-head, and a plain boxed cornice with return. Under the jerkin-head is a Roman - arched window with floor lights. Windows of the first and second stories are shuttered with plain surrounds and l/l lights. Two are placed in the second story front facade and three in the bayed first story. The main entrance, with a flat-topped transom and side panels, is located at the inside intersecting corner of the "L". An open veranda, supported by eight wooden piers, surrounds three sides of the house.

601 Woodbourne Avenue is located on a well used crosstown thoroughfare. A supermarket will be built across Ready Avenue at the right.

### STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

601 Woodbourne Avenue is designed as a typically styled house of late nineteenth century Govans. Many homes of this wooden cottage style were built (see Number 22). The contrasting feature of this building is a variation of the roof style, the jerkin-head. Other buildings in Govans with this feature can be found at 204 Cedarcroft, 4114 Lake, 509 Walker (perhaps the oldest of these dating about 1880), 606 St. Dunstan's, and 713 Woodbourne.

Except for the jerkin-head, these buildings have most of the features of the other cottage style, including the widely used, large, open veranda.




