DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two bay wide, three story high brick house is one of four similar houses standing in a row. All are owned by the City and are sealed shut with concrete and plywood.

The brick facade is laid in common bond. The basement level is marked with a set of 4 concrete steps climbing to the entrance on the left side. To the right is a segmental arched basement window.

First and second floor wall openings are segmental arch with wood sills and brick lintels. Third floor windows are of the same height as second floor windows but are flat arched with wooden sills and lintels. A slightly projecting frieze of brick surmounted by a brick mousetooth cornice run at the roofline. The roof is a gently sloping shed.




