 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This group of three contemporary, identical rowhouses is 2½ stories each with basement. Each is two bays wide with gabled roof, built of brick in running bond. All are presently owned by the City with first floor openings boarded.

High concrete stoops replace the original wood, with treads set perpendicular to the facade, lead to the entrances on the left. On the right at basement level, which is painted white, square coal chute openings remain, stripped of their doors. Each stoop has an hollow iron pipe rail at the landing.

First and second floor wall openings are segmental arched with wooden sills. Double hung windows with 6/6 lights remain on the second floor at 819 and 823, in dilapidated condition, wall openings are set symmetrically but extremely off to the sides near party walls.

Attic window openings are square and small with wooden lintels and sills.

The openings are filled with dilapidated double hung windows with 3/3 lights. A brick cornice runs at the roofline. Rectangular brick chimneys rise from the right party wall of each.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Typical of mid-nineteenth century residential construction in Sharp-Leadenhall, the essential features of this group of houses are the high basement with stairway running perpendicular to the base, segmental arched lower openings with square attic window, and shallow gabled roofs.




