DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story gable roofed house is one of the tiny alley houses that once served as homes for the servants of the more well-to-do inhabitants of Montgomery and William Streets.

The house is two stories in height, 12 1/2' wide, and occupies a lot 55' deep. The main house is two rooms deep and there is a one story high, one bay deep concrete block addition. The house is presently covered with formstone. The steeply pitched gabled roof is covered with tarpaper. A double rectangular chimney rises along the eastern side of both the front and rear gables.

The lintels and sills of the front window openings are hidden by the formstone covering, but judging from the rear windows they originally had flat wood lintels and sills. All of the window openings are filled with 1/1 sash. There is a modern flush door with lights set within the door, set beneath a single light transom. The house sits on a very low basement, the front door opening directly off the sidewalk.
