The three story, two and three bay wide brick houses lining this side of Warren Ave. were built for a middle class market and are much larger and more commodious than the average two story plus attic type of house built for nearby working class tenants. 202-220 Warren Ave. were all originally built with gable roofs but most have since been remodeled and now have shed roofs with bracketed cornices. 222-228 Warren Ave. were built in the 1870's in the currently fashionable Italianate style, with shed roofs and bracketed cornices. Each of these large, expensive houses is three bays wide and has a marble-faced basement. The first floor areas of 826-828 Warren Ave. now serve as an antique shop.

**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This three story, three bay brick house with shed roof represents a remodeling of the original three story, gable roofed structure that was built on this site in the 1850's and formed part of a group of such houses extending along this side of Warren Ave, The house is covered with formstone.

The house is three stories in height, 15' wide, and occupies a lot 96' deep. A two story high, two bay deep and wide, bowed stair hall extension connects the main house to a two story high, three bay deep rear addition. There is an extra, very narrow addition extending back another two bays. The house is presently covered in formstone, but was built in running bond. The shed roof currently has no cornice. There is a hooded chimney on the east side of the house and a rear, hooded chimney located on the north-western end of the rear addition.

The original lintels of the window openings are hidden beneath the formstone covering. The first floor door and window openings, however, have round arched lintels, like that of the neighboring house at 202 Warren Ave. All of the window openings are filled with 1/1 sash; in the first floor window the upper pane is cut to fit the round arch. A late panel door is set beneath a single light transom, the glass cut to fit the curve of the round arch. A row of quarter-round moldings separates the transom and door areas. The house sits on a low basement, the entrance being reached by two marble steps. There is a wide, rectangular basement opening with segmentally arched lintel located beneath the first floor window.

According to early views of Warren St. (the Sachse Bird's Eye Views of Baltimore), this house was originally had only two windows per floor like its neighbors. The tall, narrow proportions of the windows suggest that they were added when the gable roof was remodeled to a shed roof. The arched first floor windows were probably added at this time also, at this house as well as at 202 and 206 Warren Ave.




