Most of the small houses located along the north side of the 200 block of Churchill St. are two stories in height and two bays wide with shed roofs and late Victorian brick and metal cornices. They originally served as carriage houses for the houses to the rear facing on Montgomery St. but have since been remodeled as residences. An exception is the group of houses at 226-232 Churchill St., which are two story, gable-roofed houses typical of the type of small gable-roofed house built for a working class market in the 1850's and 1860's.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This pair of two story high, two bay wide brick houses with shed roof was originally built as a carriage house, and later converted to residential use.

The houses are two stories in height, about 13' wide, and occupy lots 48 1/2' deep. Each house is two rooms deep and there are no rear additions. The houses are constructed in running bond. The shed roof is capped by a late Victorian brick and metal cornice. There are no extant roof chimneys.

All of the door and window openings have splayed brick lintels and brick header sills. The window openings at 208 Churchill St. are filled with 1/1 double hung sash; those at 210 Churchill St. are filled with new 6/6 sash. Both houses have modern four panel doors set with upper lights. The doors are set beneath single light transoms. The houses sit on low basements, the entrances being reached by three brick steps each. Each house has a low rectangular basement opening located beneath the first floor window.
