DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This group of two story plus attic brick houses with gable roofs were built as a unit in the late 1840's, and formed part of a group of such houses extending along this side of Wheeling St. 26 and 28 Wheeling St. have been covered with formstone.

The houses are two and a half stories in height, 10 1/2' wide, and occupy lots 51' deep. The houses are two rooms deep and were originally built with a one story high, two bay deep rear addition. This survives at 26 and 28 Wheeling St. but has been replaced at 30 Wheeling St. with a modern two story high, two bay deep addition. The houses are constructed in common bond, but the facades of 26 and 28 Wheeling have been covered with formstone. The low-pitched gable roof has a continuous two-tier brick cornice extending across the entire facade. Each house has a double rectangular chimney located along ~~the eastern side of rear~~ ~~both its front and rear gables.~~ 26 and 28 Wheeling originally had a centrally located rear end chimney at the north end of the rear addition, but it is now gone.

Because of the formstone covering on 26 and 28 Wheeling St., the original treatment of the lintels and sills can be seen only at 30 Wheeling. The first and second floor door and window openings have splayed brick lintels and wood sills. The attic story windows have flat wood lintels and brick header sills. As of this writing the first floor window of 26 Wheeling is filled with a double hung 1/1 sash; the first floor window of 28 Wheeling is filled with a 6/6 double hung sash; and the first floor window of 30 Wheeling is filled with a new 9/9 double hung sash. All of the second floor windows are filled with 6/6 sash; the attic windows of 28 have 3/3 sash, and those of 26 and 30 have 1/1 sash. 26 and 28 have modified Mission-style doors, with an upper, Mission-style glass panel and a lower, regular wooden panel. 30 Wheeling St. has a modern six panel door. Each door is set beneath a narrow, rectangular single light transom. The houses sit on high basements, the entrances being reached by four brick steps each. Each house has a rectangular coal opening located to the right of the steps.
