The west side of the 1100 block of Light St. was originally improved with groups of three story, gable-roofed brick houses built in the late 1840's and early 1850's to serve as combination residential/commercial structures. 1102, 1104-1106, and 1116 Light St. survive in close to their original exterior, gable-roofed form, although all have modern storefronts. 1100 and 1114 Light St. were enlarged and remodeled after the Civil War and are now three stories in height with shed roofs and bracketed cornices. 1130 Light St. is an elaborated designed and decorated, somewhat Moorish style commercial structure, three stories in height, three bays wide, constructed in brick with brownstone and cast iron trim. The building was built in the late 1880's by Joseph and Bernard Harig to serve as a hardware store. The remainder of the block is now occupied by modern, two and three story commercial structures.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This three story, three bay brick building with shed roof and metal cornice represents either an enlargement or replacement of the original gable roofed house built on this site in the 1850's and which formed part of a row of such houses extending along this side of Light St. The first floor area has been converted into a modern store-front.

The house is three stories in height, 18' wide, and occupies a lot 66' deep. The house occupies the south-west corner of Light and South Cross Streets, and runs back along S. Cross St. for eight bays. The house is constructed in running bond. The shed roof is capped by a simple metal crown molding cornice. There are no extant roof chimneys.

The second and third floor window openings have splayed brick lintels and wood sills. The second floor window openings are filled with 4/6 double hung sash; the third floor windows are filled with 4/4 sash. The first floor area has been converted into a modern store-front. A pair of glass and aluminum doors are set diagonally to the facades under the north-east corner of the building. The doors are set beneath a wide single light transom. The entire first floor store front facade has been re-faced with new brick. Two plate glass windows are set beneath panels of aluminum siding on the Light St. facade. A deep aluminum sign area extends across the entire width of the store-front. The entrance is reached directly from the sidewalk.





