The west side of the 1100 block of Battery Ave. is improved with two distinct groups of houses, all of which, however, were built before the Civil War. At 1134-1142 Battery Ave. and at 1126-1132 Battery Ave. there are groups of three story, two bay wide, gable-roofed brick houses built in the late 1850's. At 1110-1116 and 1118-1124 Battery Ave. there are two groups of two story plus attic, two bay wide brick houses built by William Webb, a local house carpenter, in 1850. Of this group, 1112 Battery Ave. has since been enlarged to a full three stories in height but still retains its original gable roof. 1106-1108 Battery Ave. is a pair of three story, two bay wide brick houses with shed roof, but no existing roof cornice, built about 1855 with an original gable roof. Finally, at 1100-1104 Battery Ave. there is a group of two story plus attic, two bay wide brick houses, built in the early 1840's.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This pair of two story plus attic brick houses with gable roofs were built in the 1840's and formed part of a group of such houses extending along this side of Battery Ave. 1102 Battery Ave. has been covered with formstone.

The houses are two and a half stories in height, 12 1/2' wide, and occupy lots 82' deep. 1102 Battery has a modern two story high, two bay deep rear addition and 1104 Battery has a one story high, two bay deep addition. The houses are constructed in running bond, but 1102 Battery has been covered with formstone. The low-pitched gable roof has a continuous two-tier brick cornice. Each house has a double rectangular chimney located along both the front and rear roof gables. The chimneys of 1102 Battery are located along the north side of the house; those of 1104 Battery are located along the south side of the house.

The first and second story door and window openings have segmentally arched brick lintels with solid wood tympanums; the attic story windows have no lintels. All of the sills are wood. All of the window openings are filled with 1/1 double hung sash. 1102 Battery has a modern flush door; 1104 Battery has a Mission-style door. Both doors are set beneath single light transoms. The houses are set on low basements, the entrances being reached by two brick steps at 1102 and two stone steps at 1104 Battery. Each house has a small, square coal opening with metal cover located beneath the first floor window.
