DESCRIPTION:

This brick two-story rowhouse has two bays facing west and is one of a row of similar houses, some of which are now covered with Formstone. Nos. 1549 and 1551 have their original brick facades with arched openings accented by a double molding extending across the facade as a belt course. A smaller belt course molding joins the second story window sills. The window and door openings are boarded. The sills are wood. Concrete steps replace the marble steps, an example of which is seen at 1551. A bracketed and perforated cornice completes the facade. The roof is flat.
ADDITIONAL DESCRIPTION: The house was observed in January 1989 while under restoration and the boarding had been removed. The upper story windows were revealed to be intact Queen Anne type sash. The door is missing.

SIGNIFICANCE:

AREA: Architecture LEVEL: Local

The rowhouse at 1549 North Gilmore Street contributes to potential historic district in the Sandtown-Winchester area. This is one of many variations on the late nineteenth century rowhouse form and one which retains its principal features except for the window sash, door and steps. The Sandtown-Winchester area developed in the 1880's and 1890's during a period of intensive growth resulting from immigration. (The area is being surveyed currently by the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation to determine boundaries and significance of the potential historic district(s).)


