Holbrook/Ensor Historic District is significant under Criteria C for the architectural character of its buildings. The district is a concentration of two and three story late 19th century brick rowhouses adjacent to Greenmount Cemetery that were once a portion of a larger area that developed in response to the continuing northeastward expansion of Baltimore City along its major thoroughfares. The district has been separated from the Madison Square/Oliver Historic District through large scale demolition and new construction associated with urban renewal.


