

<p>Franklin Square Hospital is a large block originally designed in a modified Second Empire (French) Revival Style, as is evidenced by the mansard roof with its round-headed dormer windows with classical scroll moldings. The central bay appears to be an applied facade, perhaps a later renovation, with its brick arches and round windows, almost identical to the clinic buildings of the hospital (Nos 118 and 126 North Calhoun) to the north. The two flanking bays are also of brick, but have very heavy stone quoins and heavy keystones set in the splayed brick lintels. There is a rather ponderous classic entrance of stone supported by two plain columns and two piers, with a plain entablature. Central section is also similar to that of 1936 addition, thus entire block (the west side of Franklin Square) is based on the brick arcade motif. (Hospital plans a new building -- to be on this location ?)</p>





