1500 Hollins St. was built during the period 1854-1858 by John W. Colley. It was the first house built on Union Square. Mr. Colley subsequently built, twenty years later, the adjoining house at 1502 Hollins. Both house are english in design.



The house is unique in that it and 1502 Hollins St are the only houses on Union Square of the English design. The mahogany stairwell, is open to view from the first floor to the third. A small balcony, about four feet wide, hangs over the stair well, and front door on the inside of the house. The house has six working fireplaces, two on each of the first three floors.

The flooring in the house is random width, Georgia yellow pine. The Fireplaces on the first two floors are white Italian marble. The formal sitting rooms are on the second floor. The first floor was originally offices.



The first story has an odd belt coursing arrangement with a six inch belt course every 12 inches of wall space - attempted classicism? 


