
43 South Stricker Street is an attractive corner building with an early (if not original) store front. There is a heavy, very ornate bracketed cornice above the store (between first and second stories) and another one at the roofline. Externally, needs little more than paint at the store level - would make a good small shop. Store front should not be altered. Occupies important corner position on Union Square.


