FRANKLINVILLE UNITED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH - 1852 - Northeast corner of (No. 11846) Franklinville and Reynolds Roads. Church was organized in late 1838 and early 1839. Frame, clapboarded, Greek Revival building set on high basement. Portico and column; gable roof. Also a parsonage built in 1891 on Reynolds Road.

ST. PAUL'S EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH - 1912 - 10022 Jerusalem Road just north of Kingsville. Cornerstone of first church laid in 1850. Present building, 40 x 50 feet, built 1912. Frame and clapboard building; Gothic windows; tower with open belfry, shingled in imbricated pattern. Renovated in 1950. Parsonage built 1875.

ST. STEPHEN'S CATHOLIC CHURCH - 1889 - North side of (No. 8030) Bradshaw Road, west of Pfeiffer Road. Church in Gothic style, built of a local red stone; 57 x 76 feet; doors and windows ornamented with brick. Rose window in main facade. Square corner tower with open belfry and spire. Designed by Baltimore architect Thomas C. Kennedy. Serious fire damage to pews and paneling in December 1973, but restored. Another fire caused by the furnace, On Jan. 28, 1986.

CASINO - 1896 - Southeast corner of Bradshaw and Raphel Roads in village of Upper Falls. Frame, two-story building with corner tower; clapboarded, later covered with composition shingles. Built on a former school lot by subscription among summer residents who bought homes in this former resort area after the B & O line to Philadelphia opened the neighborhood to commuter living. A Japanese tea party was held here in 1898. Building was used for suppers, elections, service clubs. Acquired in 1907 by Upper Falls Permanent Building Association. In 1945, it was Upper Falls Lodge No. 175M, I.O.O.F.
