Located at the northwest corner of Stockton and Old York Roads in Phoenix, this Methodist church is constructed of brick, in Victorian Gothic design. Built in 1846, the church originally featured a slave gallery, and a tower was added in 1893. Established by the Pearce and Royston families, the congregation was an outgrowth to Pearce's Meeting, which gathered for worship in the Pearce home. John Bacon Pearce also donated the land for the first Manor school.
