Built on a high hill overlooking Glencoe Valley and Gunpowder Falls, Immanuel Church is a Gothic Revival stone church with buttresses and a bell cote. The cornerstone is marked 1873. The land for the Episcopal church was donated by the Austen and Mowell families. The first rector was the Rev. Duncan McCulloch of Oldfields School's founding family.
