**LORELEY SCHOOL** - 1681 - 11530 Old Philadelphia Road, 0.3 mile south of Allender Road. The first free school in Baltimore County was located on a 100-acre tract called Scholars Plains and was given by Thomas Tolley in 1723. That school was closed in 1784. The present building was put up on the same property in 1861; it is now used as a recreation center under Department of Recreation and Parks. Historic roadside marker was erected by the Baltimore County Historical Society in 1964.
