6A-1319 **NEW THEATRE** - 1934 - 51 Main Street, Reisterstown. The New Theater, now Sunny's Surplus, was built in the unit block of Main Street, east side of the road and was opened on October 19, 1934. Built in Art Deco style; yellow facing brick trimmed with vertical lines in white stone (or concrete). Original programs preserved in Mrs. Goodwin's album of 1941.

BA-1320 **GERMAN'S HOUSE** - c. 1840 - 59-61 Main Street, Reisterstown. Shown as Ducker's house in 1840.

BA-1321 **BORNHAM HOUSE** - 60 Main Street, Reisterstown.

BA-1322 **MAGISTRATES OFFICE** - - 7 East Chatsworth Avenue, Reisterstown

BA-1324 **ICE HOUSE** - - 112 Main Street, Reisterstown.

BA-1325 **ARNOLD BUNGALOW** - Built c. 1930. A cottage type residence; frame; located north of Bounds Bakers in business block. Deed 1534:44--owner was Roselle Cook. Later sold.

This is the house where in December 1977 the Arnold family was operating an antique shop.
Owner: James J. Arnold, Deeds 5738:23.
