DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

It is a white frame house on the corner of Baltimore and Alleghney avenues. It faces east towards Baltimore Ave. All the windows are double hung sash windows. There is an original section and a more recent addition.

The original portion of the house has an east-west orientation. It is 2½ stories high and has a hipped roof porch on its east and south sides. On the ground floor there are two windows on either side of the front door. On the second floor there are three windows and one above that. There is a gabled roof. On the west side there is a back door and a window on the ground floor. Recent alterations cover the second floor facade.

The newer portion of the house has a north-south orientation and bisects the original portion creating a T shaped building. It is the same height as the original part. On the east side there is a door on the first floor and two windows on both the first and second floors. On the south side there is a window on the ground floor, two on the second floor and one above. On the west side there is a small enclosed 1 story porch with a window. There are two windows on the first and second floors. The North side has two windows on the first and second floors with one above.




