GERMAN HOUSE - 1881 - 506-508 York road, Towson. Brick, Italianate style town houses with store fronts projecting to the pavement line. Bracketed cornices survive over the dwelling portions. Flat roofed. Lot was acquired in 1880 from the Ady heirs by Alexander Jackson German, and appears as J. German's house in 1898 atlas. Measurements of the dwelling were given as 48 x 50 and 40 x 86 in 1918 tax ledger when owned by John Mariner. Later owned by the Rev. Philip Sheridan of
